Alice Czech (nee Euler) was born on October 2, 1937 in Evansville, Indiana and passed away peacefully on Monday, March 16th. After graduating from Purdue University in 1959, she went on to work in the food service industry for a few years. She joined the Peace Corps in 1964 and worked for two years as a teacher in Ethiopia. Alice returned to Chicago in 1966 and continued to dedicate time working as a volunteer for many organizations while working as a teacher for the Chicago Public Schools System. She married William Czech in 1969 and raised two sons, Tony and Tim who were born in 1972 and 1974.

Alice is preceded in death by her parents, Julia and Alfred, her brother James Euler, her husband William Czech and her son, Timothy Czech. She is survived by her son Anthony (Donna), and her four grandchildren Matthew, William, Stephanie and Joseph. She is also survived by her sister Patricia (nee Martino), her sister Martha (nee Kohler), her brother Tom (Mary), and her sister Dorothy (nee Howell), daughter in law Trudy Euler as well as many nieces and nephews.
