Bernarda Gonzalez, 91 of Chicago, Illinois passed into death and into the arms of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on September 10, 2025.

Bernarda was born on August 20, 1934, the second youngest of nine children in Espino, Puerto Rico. She met the love of her life, Andres Gonzalez at the age of seven stating, "I knew I would marry him someday."
