Camille Renee Barletta, 25, of San Diego and Chicago, died May 4th, 2016 as a result of head injuries sustained in a pedestrian car accident involving a reckless driver in Newark, NJ. She was born May 13th, 1990 in the sunny city of San Diego, California. She graduated from Cathedral Catholic High School in 2008, where she swam and was a member of the drama club.

Cami went on to pursue English and Photography at Loyola University Chicago in Chicago, IL. In early 2011, she studied at the University College Cork in Ireland for a semester and later in the year met her Fiancé at Loyola Chicago. Throughout her time at Loyola, she worked for the Mitchell Museum of the American Indian in Evanston, IL.

After graduating from Loyola in 2012, Cami maintained a job at Command Transportation in Skokie, IL for over 3 years, until her adventurous spirit got the best of her and she pursued a career as a flight attendant with United Airlines. During her time at both Command and United, Cami maintained a fashion and travel blog that can be read at yourstrulyfreckleface.blogspot.com.

Cami could commonly be found snuggled up reading a good book, on a mountainous hiking trail, writing a story or her next blog post, singing or crafting things at home. Her wonderful sense of humor, positive outlook, sweet demeanor and big, bright smile brought joy wherever she went and to

whatever she did. Cami was an empowered individual, not afraid to follow her dreams or seek adventure. She is an inspiration to all of us.

Cami is survived by her loving parents Anita and Michael Barletta; her adoring siblings Rachel and Ryan; and her beloved Fiancé Pete Pascente. She also leaves her paternal grandparents Michael and Dagmar Barletta, her paternal Aunt and Uncle Lauren and Steven, her maternal aunts Lisa and Maria, her cousins of both sides and her close friends from middle school, Cathedral Catholic High School, San Diego, Loyola University, Cork Ireland, Chicago IL, and United Airlines.

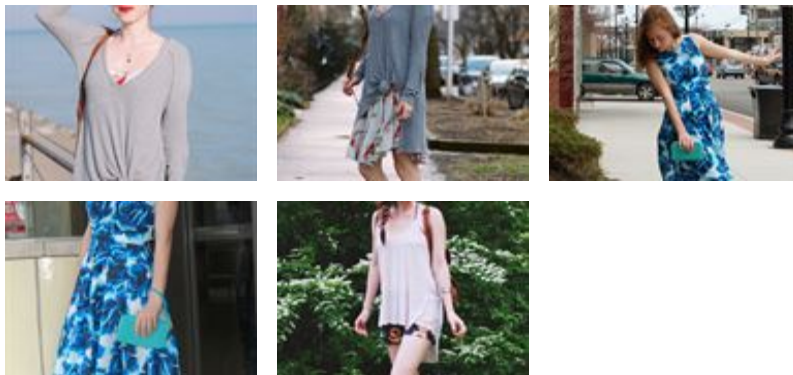
