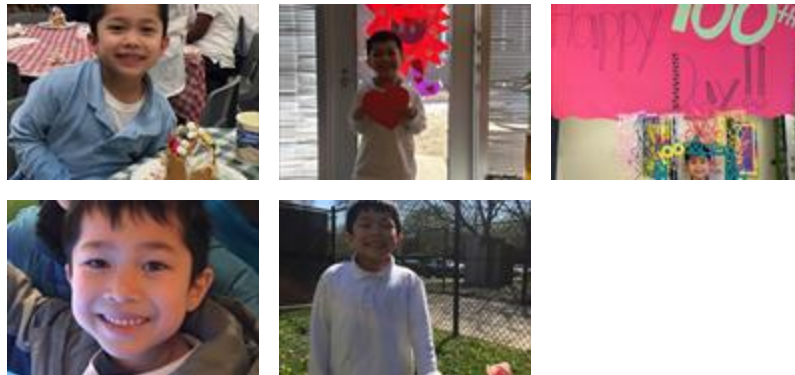

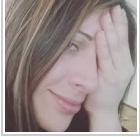

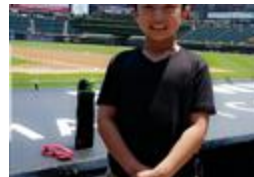
“ Carmelo,

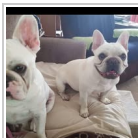

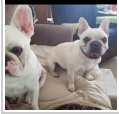
