



## Eva G Kot

September 9, 1933 - September 2, 2020

On September 2, 2020, Eva Kot (nee Gawronska) passed quietly. She is lovingly remembered by her husband of 62 years, Chrisitan Kot, daughters Joanna Kot, and Veronika Kot (Robert Thompson) her grandchildren Daniel, Jacob, Liam and Devin, and many lifelong friends. She is predeceased by her father, Casimir Gawronski and her mother, Tomira Slonska-Gawronska. Eva Kot was born in Poland on September 9, 1933. During World War II, she was deported with her family to Siberia by Soviet Union authorities. As part of an Allied agreement they were able to leave in 1942. Thereafter, as a child and refugee she experienced continuous displacement through Iran, Iraq, Eqypt, Italy and the United Kingdom, attending all the time Catholic Schools, in French, Italian and finally in English. She arrived, with her family, in the United States in 1950, where they made their home in Chicago. Eva completed her Bachelor of Science at the University of Illinois (1955) and her Masters in Biochemistry at Northwestern University (1958). While also raising her two daughters, throughout her life she worked in biomedical research, including at Rush and Northwestern Universities. Eva loved travel and the Arts.

In loving memory, may she rest in peace.
