Her warmth, humor and compassion were evident to everyone who came in contact with her.

Heloise met her husband Robert in 1997 while training with her third seeing eye dog at the 'Seeing Eye Institute' in Morristown New Jersey. Robert and Heloise were happily married for 24 years.
