Robert Francis Fucik ("Bob"), beloved husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather, passed away peacefully on June 1, 2025, in Chicago, Illinois, at the age of 85.

Born on December 31, 1939, Bob lived a life marked by love, dedication, and quiet strength. He earned his Bachelor of Science degree from DePaul University and went on to receive his medical degree from the University of Illinois Medical School. Bob and Joyce met at Illinois Masonic Hospital during his residency and were married in 1966. After his residency, Bob was a Captain in the Air Force and was stationed on Clark Air Force Base in the Philippines during the Vietnam War. He and Joyce lived on base in the Philippines for a few years, but returned to Chicago after he was honorably discharged. Bob initially practiced as an Endocrinologist for a time until he started working for Continental Insurance Company. His long and respected career culminated in his role as Medical Director at Blue Cross Blue Shield, where he made a lasting impact on the lives of many through his commitment to healthcare.

He was always there for every important event in their lives. His quiet presence and unwavering support were a source of strength and love for his family.

A wake and funeral service will be held on Saturday, June 21st at Queen of Angels Church at Queen of Apostles Parish, with the wake beginning at 10:00 a.m. and the funeral mass following at 11:00 a.m.
