Scott Gordon Kendall of Evanston, Illinois passed away at the age of 62 on January 23, 2021 after a 15-month battle with pancreatic cancer.

Scott was born on December 27, 1958 to Charles Kendall and Wanda Cheney in Columbus, Ohio. After graduating from Jefferson High School in Lafayette, Indiana in 1977, he went on to study Finance and Accounting at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, which is where he met the love of his life and his future bride, Brenda.
