“ *Making your Miniature House Better: Floor Trim* Everyone likes to tweak their dollhouses from time to time. There are some great things that you can add to your house, and I just simply came across one that helped out a lot. This big discovery was floor trim. The discovery is not entirely new, or my own, there are many places to get doll trim, but I found the cheapest is a very thin flat balsa wood. Simply paint it the color of your dollhouse and attach it to the foot of your walls. My biggest discovery is when the trim hid most of the fine mistakes between the floor and the wall. It also prevented the wall paper to come unglued because I was covering the bottom edges with the trim. This discovery truly was a small one, but I believe that it really added to my dollhouse.

*Contrasting your Colors: Making things Pop* The idea of contrast is to great stark differences between colors, furniture, textures in order to draw attention to the action. Using contrast works well to move your eye to a certain location of the room, or in a predetermined pattern. If you are planning to use color as your primary medium for contrast then refer to a color wheel - the colors opposite from one another will bring the most contrast. When dealing with color contrast remember that it is easy to over do it and come out cluttered. The standard is to restrain yourself to one contrast in a room, this way it doesn't get cluttered.

*Exterior Modeling: Getting the outside to look as good as the inside* When you have completed your dollhouse you will want people to admire the outside of your dollhouse just as much as they do the inside. The first thing that everybody looks at is the paint and the shingles. Three coats of high quality paint, recommended for dollhouses, is the minimum for dollhouse display. When you are applying the shingles first die them and then assemble them with ruler drawn lines to avoid mistakes. In addition to the paint and shingles a couple of accessories like a barbecue or bird house will add to the attractiveness. There are even tiny additions like shutters and flower pots that you can add. Last but not least is the lighting of the exterior. Lights around the porch are the most common, if you have a gazebo place a light in the center so that the light will shine down through.

*Dollhouse Flooring Options* It is the small things that once changed make the biggest difference,

*and in this case flooring is a great small change for a big difference. Flooring can be a great design medium because it is the foundation for all of your furniture. It will also add that subtle touch that really upgrades your dollhouse. Carpet, linoleum, tile, stone, and hard wood are the most popular choices in flooring options. Carpet for dollhouses is very compact and comes in sheets similar to dollhouse wallpaper. A quick fix to bathroom or kitchen rooms is linoleum and tile. The hardest type of flooring to add is a stone or hard wood option, but in the end these are the best from a designing standpoint.*
