William Paul Malloy, aged 87, died peacefully on May 22, 2024. He was born on September 14, 1936, in Chicago, Illinois to John Cyril and Jennie May (Mathis) Malloy. Bill grew up in Chicago and Jackson, TN. He was a gifted athlete, earning a football scholarship to the University of Tennessee. Injuries sustained as a defensive lineman lead him back to Chicago and Loyola University where he studied his favorite subject, history, and later earned several graduate degrees. Bill was a teacher, an arbitrator and a Deacon. His time as a Deacon was spent at Queen of All Saints Basilica in Chicago and provided him with great peace and joy. He assisted at Mass, gave homilies and made weekly Communion visits to local senior citizens.

Bill was known for his brilliance, kindness, humor and was always ready to cut a rug at weddings or on other available dance floors. After living with dementia for over a decade, Bill passed away at home surrounded by loved ones.
